



## Core Beliefs

1. We affirm the basic individual rights upon which our country was founded; that all men are created equal, endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, including but not limited to the Rights of Life, Liberty, freedom of speech, freedom of religion, etc.
2. We believe that the legitimate function of government is limited to securing our individual rights through the preservation of domestic tranquility, the maintenance of a strong national defense and the promotion of *\*Equal Justice\** for all, and any other powers specifically granted to it by the voice of the people.
3. We believe that, as citizens in a country based upon individual freedoms, we are obligated and have a personal duty to be informed of and involved in our governance. This includes our personal duty to communicate with and hold our representatives accountable by voting them out of office, if they ignore our wishes.
4. We believe in the “goodness” of the United States, the Free Market System, and Personal Initiative.
5. We call upon our representatives to bring common sense to our government and stop mis-managing our tax dollars. Congress, the Federal Reserve, and the U.S. Treasury have put the American taxpayer on the hook for over \$12 trillion in bailouts and loans. We are against massive federal spending through entitlements, National Health Care, bailouts, stimulus and spending plans, and the printing of trillions of dollars by the Federal Reserve.
6. We support an audit of the Federal Reserve. Federal Reserve Chairman Ben Bernanke recently refused to tell Congress who has received trillions in these funds from the Federal Reserve. Allowing the Fed to operate our nation's monetary system in almost complete secrecy leads to abuse, inflation, and a lower quality of life for every American.



*\*Equal Justice\* means that all three branches of government; Executive (President), Legislative (Congress) and Judicial, as well as all government agencies and employees should be subject to the same laws, rules, regulations and benefits (such as Social Security, and National Health Insurance, if passed) as any other citizen.*
